2024 KidneyCure Grants Update

The 2024 application cycle closed December 6, 2023, for KidneyCure research grants including the:

- Ben J. Lipps Research Fellowship Program
- Pre-Doctoral Fellowship Award Program
- Transition to Independence Grants Program
- · William and Sandra Bennett Clinical Scholars Program

Volunteers serving on the <u>Grants Review Committee</u> (Ben J. Lipps Fellowship Program and Transition to Independence Grants Program), the Pre-Doctoral Fellowship Review Panel, and the Bennett Review Panel reviewed over 100 applications. The KidneyCure Board of Directors will assess the committee's recommendations in April and will award grants to up to 24 investigators this year. Stay tuned for more details in July.

2024 ASN-AMFDP Announcement

Congratulations to the newest recipient of the ASN KidneyCure-Harold Amos Medical Faculty Development Program (ASN-AMFDP) Grant: Jordan Gabriela Nestor, MD, FASN. Dr. Nestor, Assistant Professor of Medicine at Columbia University, was awarded \$105,000 annually for up to four years for her research project titled *Utilizing Temporal Electronic Health Record (EHR) for Early Detection of Collagen Type IV-Associated Nephropathy (COL4A-AN)*.

The <u>ASN-AMFDP Award</u> is made in partnership between the American Society of Nephrology (ASN) and the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation's Harold Amos Medical Faculty Development Program (AMFDP) with the aim to increase diversity among future leaders in nephrology by supporting the research and career development of a kidney scholar and future health care leader from a historically disadvantaged background.
